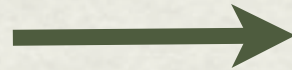

What were the similarities and differences between the texts?

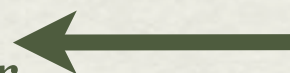

- What a long distance between the two places!

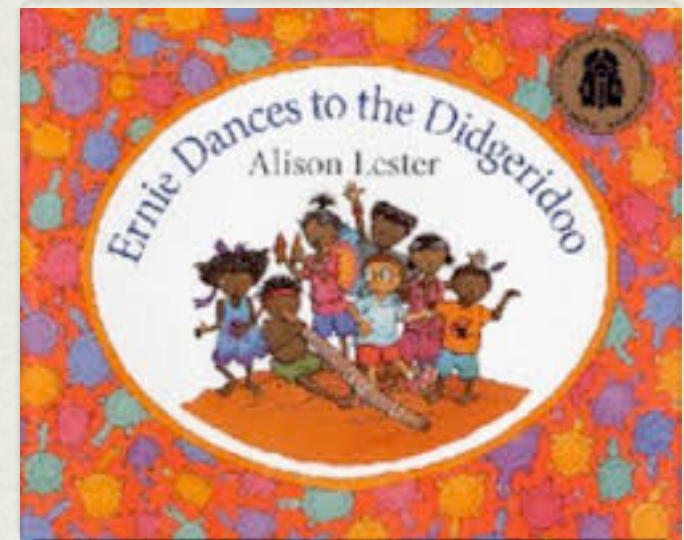


TWELVE CANOES
